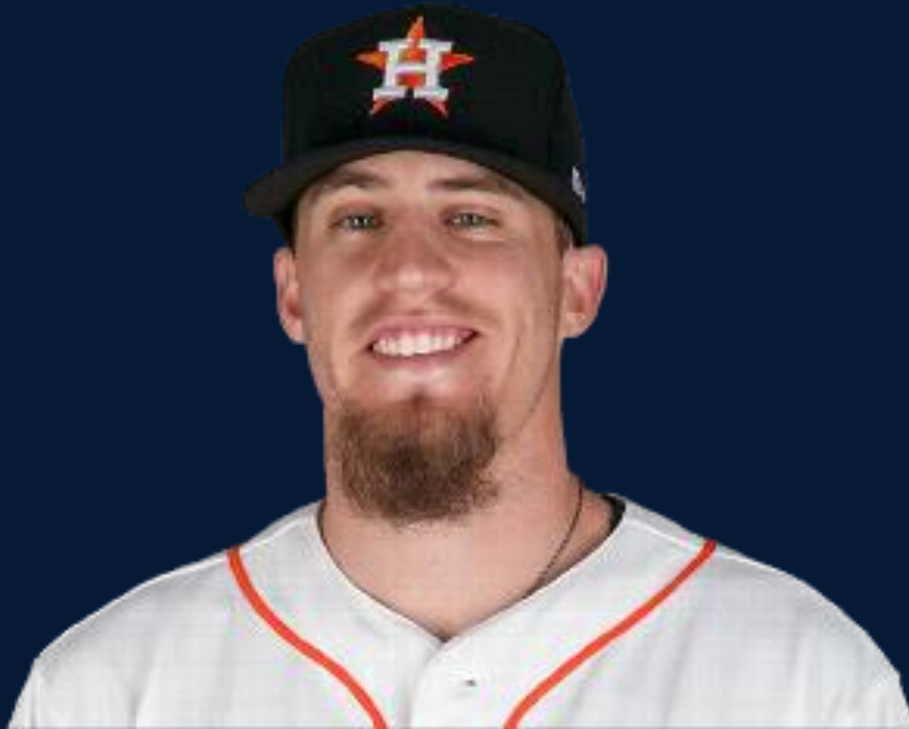

CBA SECTION VI (E) § (10)(A)-(B)

The criteria to be considered in this arbitration hearing may include:

- (1) Quality of Player's contribution to his Club during the past season ("Platform Year");
- (2) Length and consistency of his career contributions;
- (3) The record of the player's past compensation;
- (4) Comparative baseball salaries;
- (5) Existence of any physical or mental defects; and
- (6) Recent performance of the club including, but not limited to, its league standing and attendance as an indication of public acceptance.

The arbitration panel shall give particular attention, for comparative salary purposes, to the contracts of players with Major League service not exceeding one annual service group.

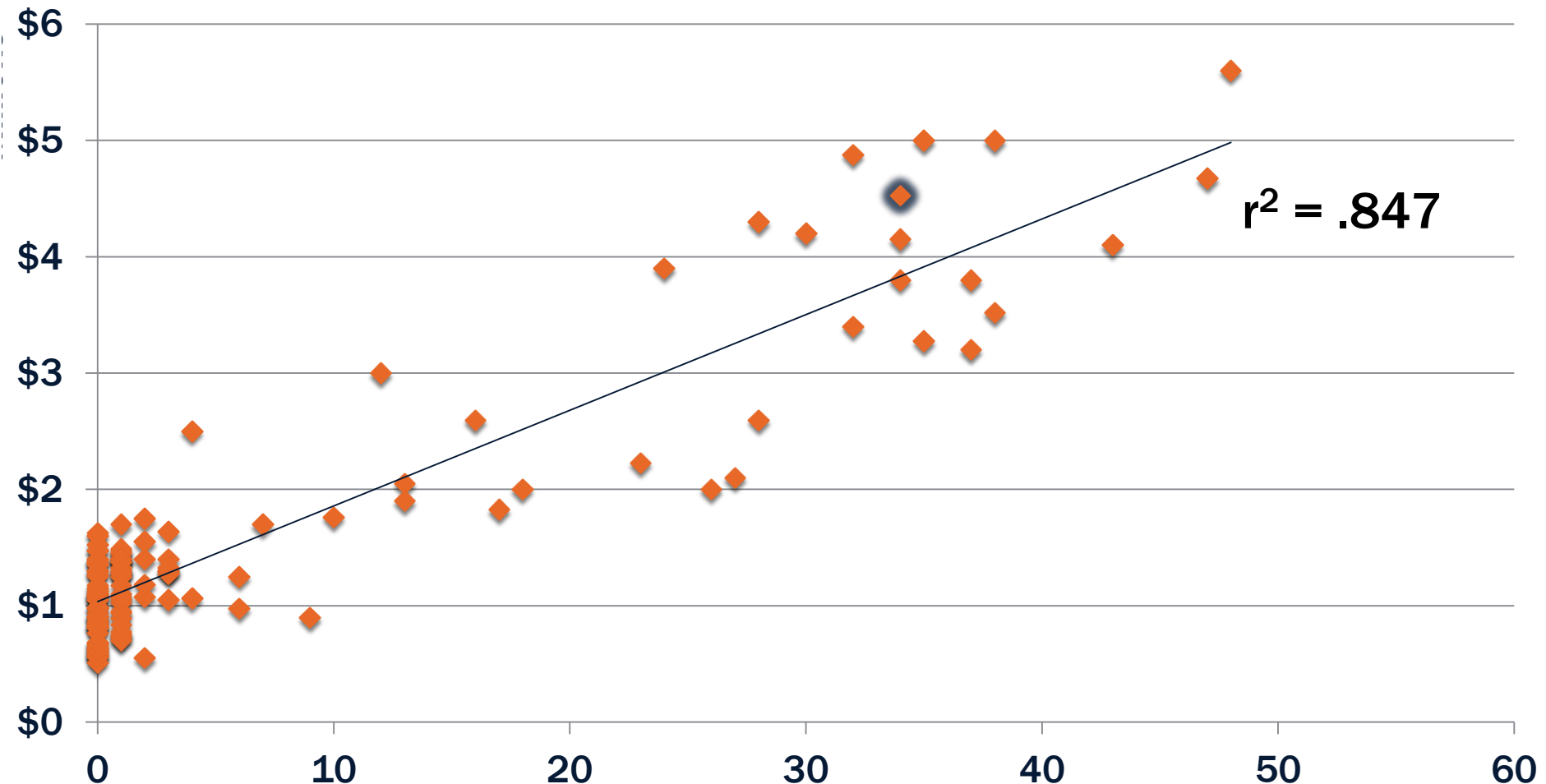

For relief pitchers, there is a very strong correlation between platform saves and eventually salary. Therefore, the most comparable players are those with the most similar save totals.

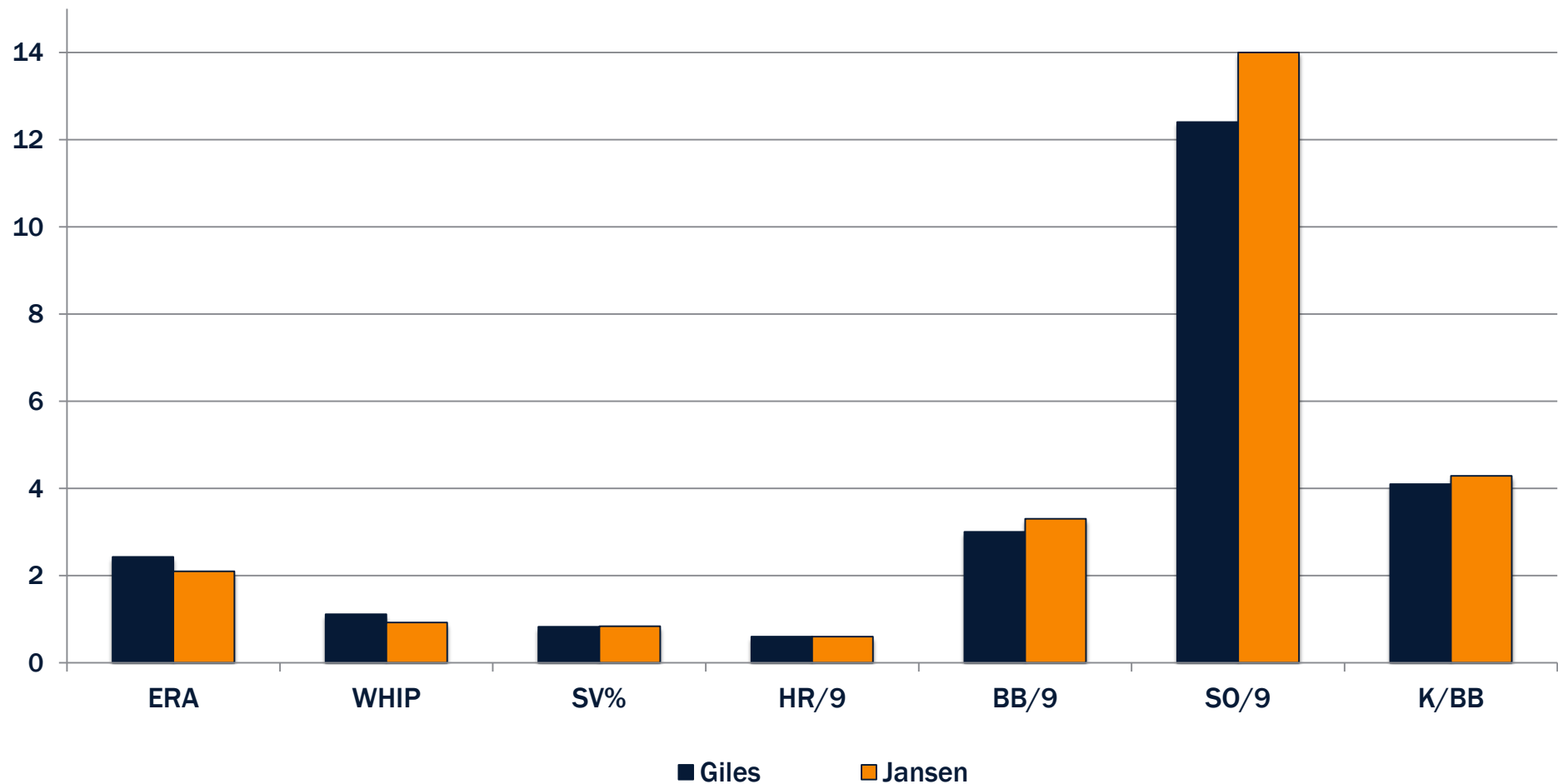

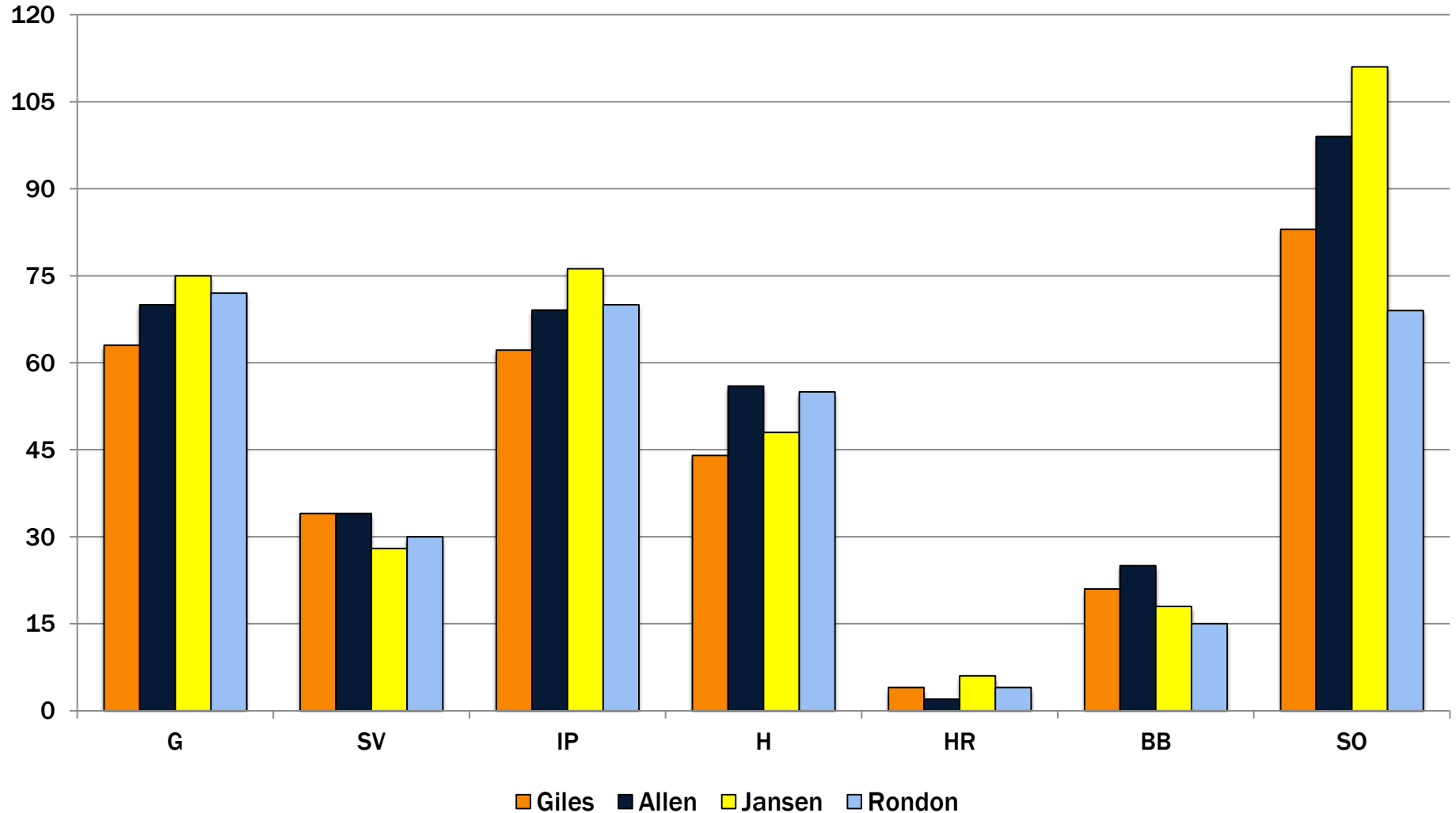

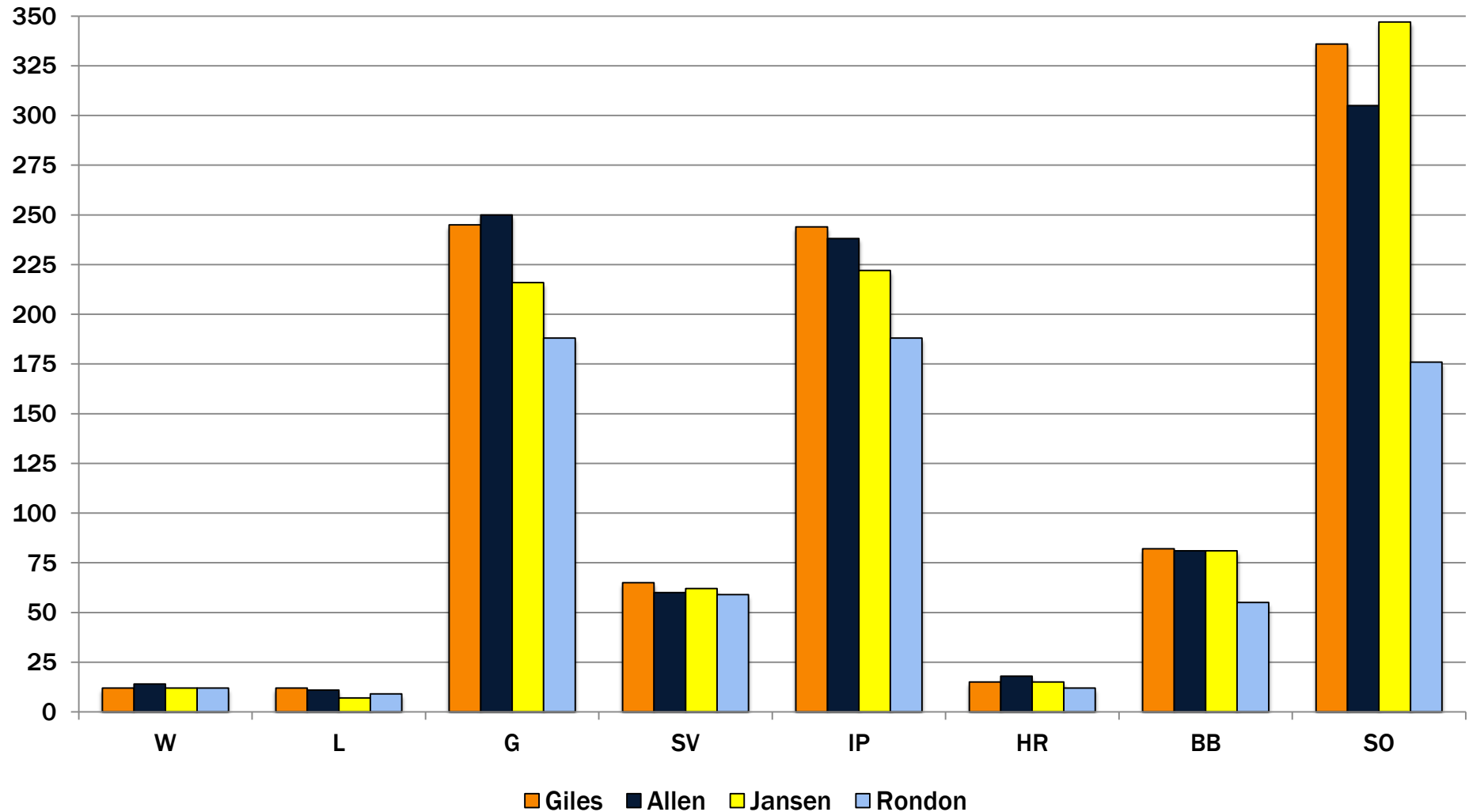
PLATFORM RATE STATISTICS OVERVIEW



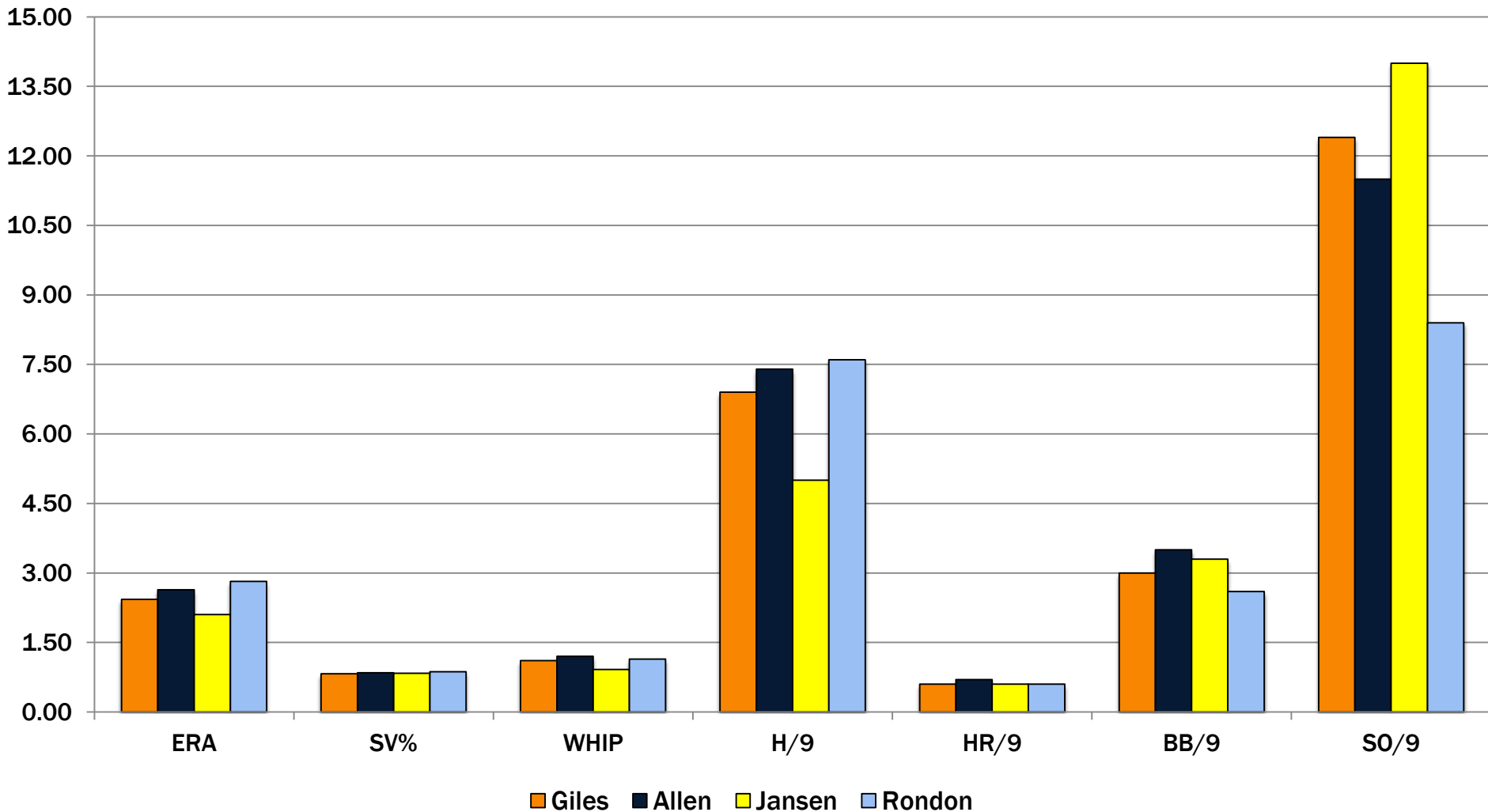
