### 2022 International Baseball Arbitration Competition

#### *Registration Materials*

Each team entering the competition must submit the online registration form and the applicable registration fee. We will not require each team to submit their payment until we have determined which registration fees will apply (i.e., in-person or Zoom); however, please note: **a team will not be registered until the Tulane Law School Sports Law Society receives both the team's registration form and the applicable fee.** The online registration form for the Advocate Competition is available through this [link](#) and the Written-Only Competition is available through this [link](#). Payment instructions will be provided once the competition format has been finalized.

**If the Competition takes place in New Orleans:** The registration fee for two-person teams is \$600 per team, if before the early registration deadline, and \$625, if after. The registration fee for three-person teams is \$800 per team, if before the early registration deadline, and \$825, if after. The fee is \$75 for a team of two or three members for the Written-Only Competition. This is separate from the advocate participation costs outlined above, and only applies to teams not participating in the Advocate Competition. The early registration deadline is Monday, November 15, 2021. Registration will close once registration forms and fees have been received from forty (40) teams.

**If the Competition takes place on Zoom:** The entry fee for two-person teams is \$250 per team, if before the early registration deadline, and \$275, if after. The entry fee for three-person teams is \$350 per team, if before the early registration deadline, and \$375, if after. The fee is \$75 for a team of two or three members for the Written-Only Competition. This is separate from the advocate participation costs outlined above, and only applies to teams not participating in the Advocate Competition. The early registration deadline is Monday, November 15, 2021. Registration will close once registration forms and fees have been received from at least forty (40) teams.

**If we do not receive your payment by Friday, December 10, 2021, your team will forfeit its spot in this year's competition, and we will accept a team on the waitlist instead.**

On the registration forms, please provide a current phone number and e-mail address for each team member. In addition, please provide an emergency contact, along with his or her phone number, and list the team's coach, if any, along with his or her contact information, position and employer. A school may indicate its desire to send a second team (the second team will only be accepted should there be unclaimed spots available after the final registration deadline) by submitting a second registration form and listing "#2" following the school name. The final registration deadline is Friday, December 3, 2021, subject to space in the competition and receipt of payment no later than Friday, December 10, 2021.

Schools that have a qualifying internal competition may register a team without specifying the team member names on the registration form. In that case, the registration form must include the contact information for the person in charge of the school's internal qualifying competition. In addition, the school must submit the applicable early or regular registration fee for a team with two

members. If the winning team of the internal qualifying competition has three members, the team must remit the remaining balance in accordance with the payment instructions above before the final payment deadline. If the winning team fails to remit payment in accordance with the foregoing, they will be limited to two team members.

If the Competition takes place in New Orleans, Louisiana, we expect that teams will arrive on Wednesday, January 19, 2022. The competition will begin early on Thursday, January 20, 2022. The quarter-final, semi-final, and final rounds will be held on Friday, January 21, 2022. The final round will be open to the public, if permitted under University and city/parish COVID-19 guidelines, with an announcement of the winning team to follow.
