During an overflight on Friday 2nd March 2018, we recorded the blockage of Crocodile Bayou by the construction of Bayou Bridge Pipeline shown below and attached.

Crocodile Bayou crosses the right of way at 30.143999°, -91.637619°, 0.7 mi west of Bayou L'Embarras.

This spoil pile has tread markings as if being used as a road.

The spoil pile extends approximately 1 mile from Bayou L'Embarras west into Haha Bay, crossing Crocodile Bayou, crossing Bay Barron.

The spoil pile / road is not gapped according to condition #20 of the permit, "the permittee shall maintain an approximate 50 foot gap for approximately every 500 feet of temporary side cast material resulting from pipeline trench activities".

The spoil is a disruption of a natural watercourse and will be capturing other sediments that will silt up the bayou, blocking recreational access of our members.
